



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If a person is not willing to acknowledge their sin and repent, there is no hope for them.




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How sad it would be for someone to perish in the Lake of fire when Jesus has paid for all of our sins by shedding His precious blood on the cross.





"Repent ye, and believe the gospel." Mark 1:15



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
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PASSING the BLAME

"And the LORD God commanded the man, saying..."




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Adam blamed Eve for his disobedience, and Eve blamed the serpent.


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
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Have you ever blamed someone for something you've done wrong?
