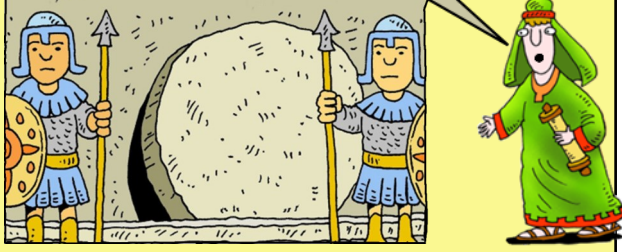


5 7. Jesus would be buried in a rich man's tomb. 700 BC

All of these were a miraculous fulfilling of old testament messianic prophecies. Jesus said...

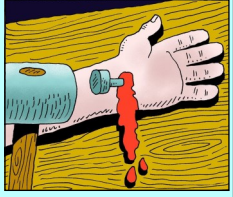
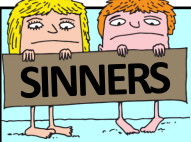
"Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil." Matthew 5:17



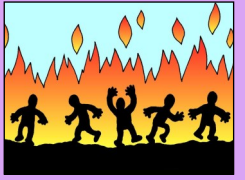

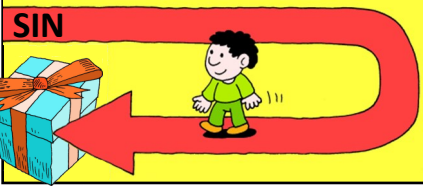
The Scripture also has a prophecy concerning those who refuse to repent. It says "The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God." Psalms 9:17

If you are willing to turn from your sins and receive Christ with a child-like faith, God will forgive all your sins and give you the free gift of eternal life.

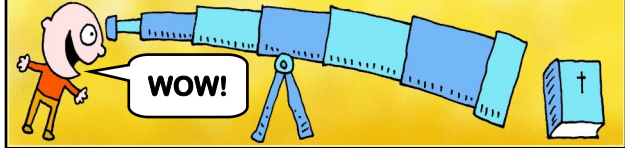

There are **over 300 prophecies** that were miraculously fulfilled the first time Jesus Christ came to this earth.

Mathematics Professor, Peter Stoner, has conservatively estimated that the chance of one man fulfilling only eight prophecies, was one in 100,000,000,000,000,000 or 10^{17} .


This is the illustration the professor gave: Suppose that we take 10^{17} of silver dollars and lay them over the face of Texas (or the country of France). They would cover all of the state (or country) two feet deep.


Now mark one of these silver dollars and stir the whole mass thoroughly...

Blindfold a man and tell him he can travel as far as he wishes, but he must only pick up the one silver dollar with the special mark on it. What chance would he have of getting the right one?...


This is impossible!!



The same chance the prophets had of writing these eight prophecies and having them all come true in one man.




What have we here!?! Let's look at just eight of the 300 prophecies...


1. Jesus would be born of a virgin. 700 BC

"Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel." Isaiah 7:14



2. Jesus would be born in the town of Bethlehem. 710 BC

"But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting." Micah 5:2



3. Jesus would preach the gospel and work miracles. 700 BC

"The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound." Isaiah 61:1


4. Jesus would be betrayed by a friend. 1000 BC
