




Jesus lived a sinless life, and when He suffered,

Those who receive Christ become the children of God. All their sins are forgiven, and they are promised eternal life, and a home with the Lord Jesus Christ in heaven.






When Unwin filled his diapers, his nice mom changed them. When Unwin was hungry, his Mom brought him all sorts of yummy things.




Unwin's Dad went to work every day.


He worked very hard to make money to provide for Unwin.
